

## Pilgrimage to the Holy Land: A Pilgrimage of Graces

Led by Fr. Bernabe Millan J. Sajonas, SSL and Golden Spirit Tours - HolyLand Pilgrimage

- **Day 1:** Arrival in Tel Aviv or Jordanian Border where you will be welcomed by our representative and transfer to the hotel in Nazareth. Dinner and overnight stay in Nazareth.
- **Day 2:** After breakfast, head to the city of Nazareth and the Basilica of the Annunciation. Next to the Basilica is the Church of St. Joseph, where it is still possible to visit the remains of the old carpenter's shop. After lunch, visit to Cana of Galilee, the place where Jesus performed his first miracle changing the water into wine. We will ascend Mount Tabor, where the transfiguration of Jesus took place. In the late afternoon, return to Nazareth. Dinner and overnight stay in Nazareth.
- **Day 3:** Breakfast and departure to Magdala, Mount of Beatitudes, site of the Sermon on the Mount. Then proceed to Tabgha where the miracle of the breaking of the Loaves took place and a visit to the Church of the Primacy of Peter. In Capernaum, we will visit the remains of the ancient synagogue where Jesus preached. Then we will carry out the pilgrimage by boat on the Sea of Galilee. Break for lunch and in the afternoon, we will visit the Jordan River, where we will renew the sacrament of Baptism. Return to Nazareth in the late afternoon. Dinner and overnight stay in Nazareth.
- **Day 4:** After breakfast, visit Jericho, the oldest and the lowest city in the world. Stop at Zachaeus' Sycamore tree and proceed for an overview of the Mount of Temptation where Satan tried to tempt Jesus. Continue to the Dead Sea for some swimming and relaxation, then head to Qumran, where the famous Dead Sea Scrolls were found. After lunch, visit to Masada, the last fortress of the Jews in their struggle against the Romans. At the end of the day, we will head to Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight stay in Jerusalem.
- **Day 5:** After Breakfast, visit the Mount of Olives with the Church of the Ascension, the Church of the Pater Noster, Dominus Flevit, the Tomb of the Virgin Mary, the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of the Agony. After lunch, visit the Pool of Bethesda and the Church of Saint Anna. Free Time in the old city and shopping at the bazaar markets. Dinner and overnight stay in Jerusalem.
- **Day 6:** Early breakfast followed by a visit to Via Dolorosa, the Calvary and the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Continue to the Wailing Wall, the Dome of the Rock and in Mount Zion, we will visit the Last Supper Room and the Church of the Dormition Abbey. After Lunch, visit St. Peter's Church in Gallicantu. At the end of the day, return to the hotel. Dinner and overnight stay in Jerusalem.
- **Day 7:** After Breakfast, head to David's tower in Jaffa gate then continue to Ein Karem, birthplace of John the Baptist and the Church of the Visitation. Have Lunch at Ein Karem then proceed to Bethlehem city for free time. Dinner and overnight in stay Bethlehem.
- **Day 8:** After Breakfast proceed to visit the Church and Grotto of the Nativity where Jesus Christ was born, then continuing to Milk Grotto, where you'll find a church built over the Shrine of the Milk Grotto where the Virgin Mary was nursing baby Jesus. After lunch, visit the shepherd's field in Beit Sahour, where the "Shepherds kept watch". On the night that

Christ was born, the site is also well known for its ancient Olive Trees that date back to the time before the birth of Jesus Christ. Free time in the old city of Bethlehem and shopping at the bazaar markets. Dinner and overnight stay in Bethlehem.

- **Day 9:** After breakfast, we bid farewell to the Holy Land as we drive to the airport to board our departure flight back home.
