Life with its joys and sorrows is the road that the adult takes to mature the relationship with God and progress in holiness. Formation should involve the whole human person, crossing the existential questions of people. Its mission is to send people and Christian communities to evangelize and to witness into the world.

The Commission's Pedagogical Responsibilities in Catholic Christian Communities in the Diocese of Prince Albert

Lay – help Adult Faith Formation Coordinators, provide materials/resources for Adult Faith Formation (scripture, creed, prayers, retreats, faith related topics), and help in RCIA catechesis (teaching formation, resources/materials)

Family – priority on Marriage

Life – To address theological questions, to address life issues (such as on divorce, environment, etc.), and to send people and Christian communities into active mission (Outreach, Mystagogy)
